



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions refer to scholarships to be awarded by Foundry (EBNZR Pty Ltd ABN 56 601 529 944), also referred to as "Foundry" and relate to the Associate Degree of Applied Design (Z2E), referred to as the Associate Degree of Applied Design, which is delivered by Foundry via a third party partnership agreement with the University of Tasmania's University College ABN 30 764 374 782. CRICOS Provider Code 00586B, also referred to as "the University."

DATES

1. Applications for scholarships for students commencing their 'Foundry Pathway', in relation to the Associate Degree in Applied Design element of this pathway delivered by Foundry (EBZNR Pty Ltd) in partnership with the University of Tasmania's University College are now open as of Tuesday, 16th October, 2018 for study commencement in February 2019.
2. A Foundry Pathway is the term used to describe the program which includes, but is not limited to the delivery, as a third party partner of the University of Tasmania's University College, in the delivery of the Associate Degree of Applied Design.
3. The scholarships will apply only to the 2 year Associate Degree of Applied Design element of the Foundry Pathway as described above.
4. Applications for scholarships for students commencing their Foundry Pathway in Term 1 (February), 2019 are open from Tuesday, 16th October, 2018 to Sunday, 23rd December, 2018.
5. Two (2) Director's / Board Scholarships (2019 Pathway Scholarships) are available for tuition fees for the full duration of the Associate Degree in Applied Design including Student Services and Amenities Fees.
- 5 a) Two (2) Foundry Bursaries (Creative Assistance Packages) are available for either a MacBook Pro or additional financial assistance with regards to travel or relocation. This package has been implemented to assist prospective students who would not otherwise be able to attend without access to this level of support.
6. The scholarships will be given in the form of a fee waiver at the start of the University of Tasmania's Semester One (referred to in Foundry materials as 'Term 1'), provided that the student is enrolled in a full-time load in the eligible Associate Degree of Applied Design degree on the census date of that semester.



ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be an Australian citizen at the time of application.
2. Applicants must be successful with a Foundry and UTAS application to be eligible for this program.
3. Successful applicants who are offered the scholarship must accept their offer to study a Foundry Pathway and an Associate Degree of Applied Design via both Foundry's and the University's offer and acceptance processes.
4. The scholarship selection committee shall announce the scholarship winners for the 2018 scholarships by Monday, 14th January, 2019.
5. All decisions are made by the scholarship selection committee and are final.
6. Students who are successful with their application ("the scholarship recipient") will be notified by telephone and email.
7. Information on how to apply for a scholarship form part of these Terms and Conditions.
8. The submission of an application is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
9. Students who submit an application consent to Foundry using their name, likeness, image and/or voice in the event they are a winner (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this scholarship scheme.

ACTIONS RENDERING THE SCHOLARSHIP VOID

1. The scholarship recipient will forfeit their scholarship if they repeat units, or defer their Associate Degree in Applied Design before commencing or prior to graduation.
2. This scholarship cannot be combined with any other Foundry or University of Tasmania scholarship or bursary.
3. This scholarship is non-transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
4. If at any stage during or following the process of assessing and awarding a scholarship, documents are found not to be genuine, the scholarship will be immediately withdrawn. The Foundry and the University exclude all liability to the maximum extent permitted by law.



5. To remain eligible for the Director's/ Board Scholarships, the successful students must remain enrolled full-time (100% per year) in the Associate Degree of Applied Design and achieve a Credit average at the end of each academic year.
5. a) To remain eligible for the Foundry Bursaries, the successful students must remain enrolled full-time (100% per year) in the Associate Degree of Applied Design and achieve a Pass average at the end of each academic year.
6. The successful student must observe Foundry's rules of conduct and behaviour otherwise this scholarship will be revoked immediately.
7. Scholarship recipients may not defer their commencement date.

VARIATION OF TERMS

The University of Tasmania and Foundry reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time at the discretion of either party.
